

PALM SUNDAY

GOOD FRIDAY

We hear again the account of Our Lord's Passion and Death, and venerate the Cross.

HOLY SATURDAY

During the daytime, the Church is empty, like a tomb.

At night-time, passages from the word of God unfold God's work for our salvation from sin and death; the Easter Candle, symbol of Christ risen, is lit and carried through the darkness, to the sanctuary. The New Life of the Resurrection is proclaimed.
