PALM SUNDAY

We commemorate Our Lord's
triumphant entry into Jerusalem, and His
Passion and Death.

MAUNDY THURSDAY

We re-enact the Last Supper; the
demonstration of service in the washing of
the disciples' feet; join in as Our Lord
establishes His permanent gift to us of
Himself in Holy Communion, the Eucharist;
and keep watch with Him during his prayer
and agony in the garden.

GOOD FRIDAY

We hear again the account of Our Lord's
Passion and Death, and venerate the Cross.

HOLY SATURDAY

During the daytime, the Church is empty,
like a tomb.

At night-time, passages from the word of
God unfold God's work for our salvation
from sin and death; the Easter Candle,
symbol of Christ risen, is lit and carried
through the darkness, to the sanctuary. The
New Life of the Resurrection is proclaimed.
